Category 9	Products with body and hand exposure, primarily rinse off. Bar soap, Liquid soap, shampoo of all type, conditioner (rinse-off), body washes and shower gels of all types	2.88%
Category 10A	Household care excluding aerosol products (excluding aerosol/spray products). Fragranced oil for lamp ring, reed diffusers, pot-pourri, liquid refill for air fresheners (non-cartridge systems), etc.	2.88%
Category 10B	Air freshener sprays, manual, including aerosol and pump	18.17%
Category 11A	Products with intended skin contact but minimal transfer of fragrance to skin from inert substrate without UV exposure	0.11%
Category 11B	Products with intended skin contact but minimal transfer of fragrance to skin from inert substrate with potential UV exposure	0.11%
Category 12	Products not intended for direct skin contact, minimal or insignificant transfer to skin. Candles of all types	100.00%
